Our Burgundy – Franche-Comté region is large and has many local producers and breeders. For our greatest pleasure, we take advantage of this know-how to offer our Table the best possible products.

But our role is even greater because today the environmental dimension must be at the center of all reflections.

All our meats are cooked at low temperature to preserve their quality. Our dishes are homemade and prepared on site from fresh products.

A gastronomic concept at the service of ecology

- *A concept of Mystery Menu* to respect the rhythm of nature, our breeders, our producers but above all to considerably reduce our food waste by arriving at almost zero loss.
- *No paper printing of menus!*
- *The management of our compost* which is essential to us. The park of our House allows us to make our shredded material and to reuse on our plantations, the matured compost.
- *The installation of filtered water* is a logical follow-up to our “EcoTable” idea. No more transport, no more wasted glass, or industrial washing, no more handling... Pure water that comes from here!
- *Aromatic herbs and edible flowers come from our garden.* We also go picking to make our oils, our powders, our recipes... Soon, we will create our vegetable garden!
- *We “force” our suppliers to ban plastic from packaging!* Our goal being 0 plastic, it makes sense to ban this product from packaging and our request is heard! Make way for cardboard, glass, or biodegradable packaging (cornstarch) even if it must be recognized that the implementation of recyclable plastic is already a serious step forward.
- We have subscribed to a *green electricity contract* which guarantees us a minimum of 60% supply from renewable energy. Our rooms are also fully equipped with low consumption LED bulbs.
